Trainer Expectations:

- Attend at least one riding clinic per year

- Ride client horses at least 5 times per week for 30+ minutes
- Video updates once a week if not more
- Continuing education throughout the year books, digital clinics, videos, etc.
- Rates include hay, boarding, and training
- Cleveringa Equine feed with Zesterra will be provided daily to ensure quality nutrition and absorption. The Zesterra included in the feed will help with the stress of a new environment & to prevent ulcers during their time in training

- If you wish to provide grain other than Cleveringa Equine complete feed that is provided, you can do so at your own expense.
- Horses must be up-to-date on all vaccinations, worming, dental and farrier
  - A health certificate/invoice/proof of will be required for vaccinations, worming and dental
  - If you do not have these done, I will have it done for you and will invoice you for the charges
- Must have a negative coggins if out of state
- If being hauled & seasoned \$0.50/mile fee will be invoiced
- Exhibitions & entry fees are your responsibility
- Discounted MagnaWave sessions at \$50/session, if I feel the horse is in need of this it will be communicated to you

These horses are athletes and should be treated as such. If they don't feel great, it is difficult to get great results from my riding as a trainer. If I feel they are sore and need chiropractic and/or MagnaWave treatments I will discuss this with you, and then I will also include those fees on the invoice if you consent to having those treatments done. I will take care of these horses like they are my own.
